This sermon takes us to Exodus 14:10-14. Moses was trying to deliver the instructions from God to the Israelites. Every time that God gave a word and directions for the people, they were never satisfied. "The enemy was on his way to capture what he already had." Sister Ruby Hargrove presented temperance. Spiritual self-control is needed on our walk. Special thanks to our MC sister Victoria Richardson.

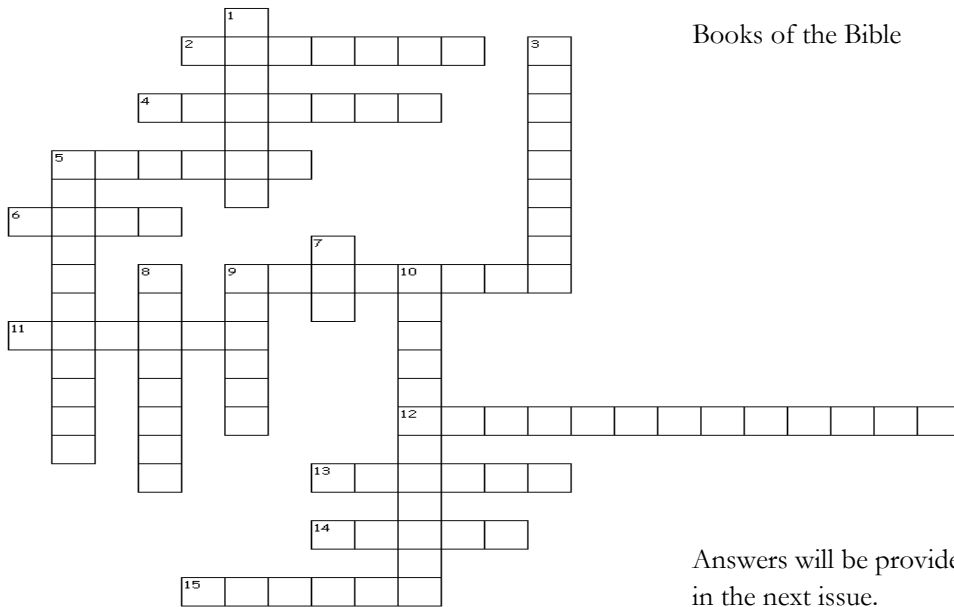

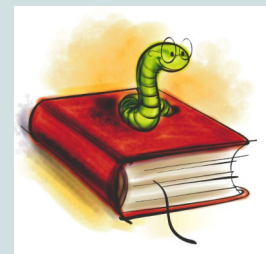
