

Tamarkus T. Cook Legacy Scholarship Scholarship Fund Program Guidelines

The Tamarkus T. Cook Legacy Scholarship (TTCSF) is dedicated to helping individuals in the targeted communities of Coweta County Georgia to attend to and succeed in the educational arena. The belief that "every child can and will learn with the proper educational resources" is echoed throughout the Program's work. The Tamarkus T. Cook Legacy Scholarship Committee facilitates partnerships with key stakeholders to increase academic achievement of individuals in the targeted communities.

The *Mission* of Tamarkus T. Cook Legacy Scholarship is to match deserving students with tools and resources necessary to attain higher education.

The *Vision* of Tamarkus T. Cook Legacy Scholarship is to empower the scholarship recipients to reinvest their gifts in the designated area with need-based educational resources.

The *Purpose* of the Tamarkus T. Cook Legacy Scholarship is to provide scholarships to deserving high school graduating seniors intending to pursue a course of study at a four-year educational institution.

For 2018, the TTC Legacy Scholarship Fund's individual maximum award is \$2,500. TTCLS will award approximately three (3) scholarships, in amounts from \$2,500 per award, based on applicant's college/university choice.

NOTE: Scholarship funds will be awarded to the student upon evidence of acceptance in an accredited higher educational institution.

Criteria and eligibility (TTCLS Scholarship Fund applicants)

- 1. Applicant must attend a High School in Coweta County.
- 2. Applicant must be a graduating high school senior in the year of the award.
- 3. Applicant must demonstrate community involvement, improvement in academics, and desires to attend college.

For the Talented Tenth Award, TTCLS will award one (1) scholarship in the amount of \$2,500. *Criteria and eligibility (Talented Tenth Award applicants)*

- 1. Applicant must attend a high school in Coweta County.
- 2. Applicant must be a graduating high school senior in the year of the award.
- 3. High School Transcript: Applicant must have at least a 3.5 grade point average.
- 4. One 3- page essay detailing your service to a minority or underserved community.
- 5. Three (3) letters of recommendation: One from a school administrator, one from a current or previous teacher and finally one from a member of the Coweta County community at large.
- 6. Proof of Acceptance and commitment to a four- year institution.
- 7. Applicant must demonstrate impactful community involvement and a vision to better the community through the attainment of higher education.
- 8. Letter of application addressed to the Scholarship Committee. The letter should contain a brief explanation about yourself and your college plans (college/university, intended major, and anticipated start date). Letter should not exceed one (1) page.

For the Kirby Family Award, TTCLS will award one (1) scholarship in the amount of \$2,500. *Criteria and eligibility (Kirby Family Award applicants)*

- 1. Applicant must attend a high school in Coweta County.
- 2. Applicant must be a graduating high school senior in the year of the award.
- 3. High School Transcript: No minimum GPA required.
- 4. One 3- page essay detailing your high school experience as a single parent.
- 5. Three (3) letters of recommendation: One from a school administrator, one from a current or previous teacher and finally one from a member of the Coweta County community at large.
- 6. Proof of Acceptance and commitment to a four- year institution.
- 7. Applicant must demonstrate active participation in the community and be a positive member of their school community.
- 8. Letter of application addressed to the Scholarship Committee. The letter should contain a brief explanation about yourself and your college plans (college/university, intended major, and anticipated start date). Letter should not exceed one (1) page.

For The Village Award, TTCLS will award one (1) scholarship in the amount of \$2,500. *Criteria and eligibility (The Village Award applicants)*

- 1. Applicant must attend a high school in Coweta County.
- 2. Applicant must be a graduating high school senior in the year of the award.
- 3. High School Transcript: No minimum GPA required.
- 4. One 3- page essay detailing your high school experience as a student who has faced academic challenges and describe how you are going to overcome those challenges while matriculating through college.
- 5. Three (3) letters of recommendation: One from a school administrator, one from a current or previous teacher and finally one from a member of the Coweta County community at large.
- 6. Proof of Acceptance and commitment to a four- year institution.
- 7. Applicant must be accepted and committed to a four- year institution and be extremely active and a positive member of their community and school.
- 8. Letter of application addressed to the Scholarship Committee. The letter should contain a brief explanation about yourself and your college plans (college/university, intended major, and anticipated start date). Letter should not exceed one (1) page.

General Instructions

- 1. **DEADLINE** for scholarship applications is **Friday**, **April 13, 2018, 5:00 p.m.** (no exceptions).
- 2. Refer to application process below for a list of the supporting documents needed (i.e., reference forms, evidence of GPA- Transcripts, etc.) Incomplete applications will not be considered.
- 3. If any question does not apply to you in this application please put N/A in the space.
- 4. Applications must be typed. Handwritten applications will not be considered. You may also download a copy of the application online at <u>www.SaintSmyrnaBC.org./TTCscholarship18</u>.
- 5. These scholarships are available to all persons, without regard to any differences of race, of color, or of nationality.
- 6. You will be notified by mail in May regarding the status of your application.
