



Tips on the new Coronavirus • www.cdc.gov/covid19 is a reliable source of information

- Avoid close contact with those who are sick
- Avoid touching your eyes, nose and mouth
- Those who are sick have symptoms like a cold or the flu-fever, dry cough, body aches
- If you are sick, stay home (do not go to work, church, or visit the sick or elderly)
- Cough or sneeze into your elbow or a tissue, then throw the tissue away
- Stay hydrated and monitor your health. Most people will get well in several days. Consult your doctor if it becomes more difficult to breathe after a few days
- We are still in the flu season. If you develop a fever, cough and body aches it may be the flu. If you have not gotten the flu shot there is still time (unless not recommended by your doctor).
- Washing your hands with soap and water or an alcohol based hand sanitizer is a good way to protect your health
- Wash your hands for at least 20 seconds with soap and water after you cough, sneeze, or blow your nose
- Disinfect objects that are commonly touched such as door handles and light switches

The majority of people infected with this new virus will recover from it. Some of those infected my develop pneumonia which results in difficulty breathing and can be serious.
